Fruit Trees



Apple – Crimson Crisp®

PP16,622.

A delicious, crisp, medium sized apple with attractive deep-crimson skin. The flavor of the light-yellow flesh is a perfect balance of sweet and tart. Best for fresh eating. Good disease resistance. Mid-season bloomer. Pollinator required. Semi-dwarf.

Apricot – Robada

A large, robust apricot with vibrant red blush and orange flesh. Flavorful, aromatic and easy to peel. Best for fresh eating, canning, drying and freezing. Freestone. Self-pollinating.

Guava – Chilean Guava- Ugni molinae – Chilean Guava

An attractive shrub, when in flower, covered profusely with small, fragrant, white flowers. Delicious fruit with a distinct guava flavor follows. Best grown in a container and brought indoors in colder climates. Self-fertile. Mature at 3' – 6' tall and wide.

Jujube - GA866 – Ziziphus jujube

Large, elongated fruit, also as known as Chinese date, has a very high sugar content and is good for fresh eating, candied, canned, as preserves or dried. Requires cross-pollination from another jujube with a similar bloom time. Drought tolerant. Mature at 12'- 16'. Zone 6. #7



Jujube Shanxi Li - Ziziphus jujube

A striking ornamental tree with attractive contorted branching, which also produces large, very crisp, sweet fruit. Reddish brown when ripe, this jujube variety is best for fresh eating or dehydrating. Plant two jujube varieties for best fruit production. Not bothered by pests or diseases. Mature at 8' – 10'.

Peach – Harvester - Prunus persica

Profuse pink blossoms followed by heavy crops of medium sized, freestone orange-yellow fruit blushed deep carmine in mid-late summer. Firm, sweet and juicy fruit is good for fresh eating, baking and canning. Self-pollinating.

Pear-- Tsu Li Asian Pear

An ancient heirloom cultivar from China, which produces a medium to large, light green to yellow, oval shaped, dessert pear. This pear has white flesh with a tinge of yellow and is sweet, crisp and juicy with a subtle floral taste and pineapple aroma.

A vigorous, very productive pear tree. Self-fertile.

Plum - AU Rosa – Prunus ‘Santa Rosa’ x Prunus ‘Starcher No. 1’

An improved version of Santa Rosa Japanese plum from the Auburn University. Fragrant white flowers attract a multitude of pollinators. Delicious fruit has bright red skin and yellow flesh, best for fresh eating, jam, baking, canning, freezing. Good disease resistance. Ripens in mid-August. Self-pollinating.

Small Fruit



Aronia – Viking – Black Chokeberry - Aronia melanocarpa ‘Viking’

An attractive, easy to grow native plant with glossy green foliage and pink-tinged white blooms. Wine-black berries are antioxidant rich and ripen in late summer. Good for jams, preserves, wine and baking. Cold hardy. Self-pollinating. Mature at 5' – 6' tall and wide.

Blueberry – Duke -*Vaccinium corymbosum* – Duke Blueberry

A stocky, upright northern highbush blueberry. Early ripening, large, firm, light blue blueberries with mild flavor. Best for fresh eating. Mature at 4' - 6' tall and wide.

Bushel & Berry® - Blueberry Buckle® - 'Corablue'

PP 22,521 Small, sweet, dark blueberries. Attractive shrub with white flowers and glossy, dark green, boxwood-like foliage. Low water and chill hour requirement, good for warmer climates.

Mature at 2'-3' tall and wide.

Elderberry – Samdal – *Sambucus nigra* 'Samdal'

An introduction from Denmark. Fruit is borne on shoots produced the prior growing season, starting as tiny white flowers developing into clusters of small flavorful black berries, which ripen in August. Fruit is best for jams, jellies, juices and cordials. Vigorous 6' – 8' x 2'- 5'.

Cross-pollinate with Samyl.

Elderberry – Samyl – *Sambucus nigra* 'Samyl'

An introduction from Denmark. Fruit is borne on shoots produced the prior growing season, starting as tiny white flowers developing into clusters of small flavorful black berries, which ripen in August. Fruit is best for jams, jellies, juices and cordials. Vigorous 6' – 8' x 2'- 5'.

Cross-pollinate with Samdal. Zone 3.

Fig – Fignomenal – *Ficus carica* hybrid

An excellent choice for container growing. Sweet, medium sized fruit ripens brown on the outside with reddish flesh.

Everblooming thus everbearing. Bring in indoors for year around fruit. Place in full sun. Self-pollinating. Mature at 2' – 3' tall and

wide. Zone 7. #5



Grape – Catawba Red - *Vitis labrusca* x *vitis vinifera* ‘Sémillon’

A vigorous, hardy, deciduous grapevine bearing medium sized clusters of round, purple-red fruit. An excellent choice for wine, juice, jams and jellies and fresh eating.

Zone 4. #2



Mulberry –Everbearing Dwarf - *Morus nigra*

A mulberry with a small space requirement. Fruit is medium to large in size, black when ripe and wonderfully sweet.

Great for fresh eating, jams, jellies and wine. Self-pollinating.

Multi-stemmed or trained to a tree-form. Can be pruned after fruiting to maintain a 2'- 6' height, otherwise it is mature at 10'- 15' tall x 15'- 20' wide.

Mulberry Red - *Morus rubra* – Red Mulberry

A medium sized, upright, spreading and rounded fruit tree.

When ripe the 3/4" – 1" fruit is red to deep purple in color and relished by humans and wildlife, Self-fertile,

Mature at 35' – 55' tall x 30' – 40' wide.

Shrubs



Arborvitae – Junior Giant – *Thuja x plicata* ‘Junior Giant’

PP# 31,297 A smaller version of Green Giant. Great for an evergreen privacy hedge in a smaller landscape. Deer resistant. Mature at 15' – 20' x 5' – 10'.

Azalea – Perfecto Mundo® Double Dark Pink – Proven Winners® -*Rhododendron* x

A dense, rounded, evergreen, reblooming azalea with lovely dark pink flowers. After a spring bloom and brief rest, this selection blooms again from mid-summer until frost. Resistant to lacebugs.

Mature at 2 1/2' - 3 x 3' - 4'.

Azalea – Perfecto Mundo® Double Pink – Proven Winners® - Rhododendron x

A neat, rounded, evergreen, reblooming azalea with subtle pink flowers. After a spring bloom and brief rest, this selection blooms again from mid-summer until frost. Resistant to lacebugs.

Mature at 2' – 3' tall and wide.

Zone 6. #3



Azalea – Perfecto Mundo® Double Purple – Proven Winners® - Rhododendron x

A thrilling, mounded, evergreen, reblooming azalea with ruffled, deeply-saturated purple flowers. After a spring bloom and brief rest, this selection blooms again from mid-summer until frost.

Resistant to lacebugs. Mature at 2 ½' – 3' x 3'.

Azalea – Perfecto Mundo® Double White – Proven Winners® - Rhododendron x

A neat, rounded, evergreen, reblooming azalea with classy flowers. After a spring bloom and brief rest, this selection blooms again from mid-summer until frost. Resistant to lacebugs.

Mature at 2 ½' – 3' x 3' -4'.

Azalea – Perfecto Mundo® Red – Proven Winners® - Rhododendron x

A rounded evergreen, reblooming azalea with rich red flowers. After a spring bloom and brief pause, this blooms again from mid-summer until frost. Resistant to lacebugs.

Mature at 2 ½' x 3' – 4'.

Camellia – April Dawn Blush - Camellia japonica 'April Dawn Blush' – April Dawn Blush Camellia

Formal, double, bicolored medium sized blooms in light pink with a white border. An occasional deeper pink stripe adds a lovely highlight. Vigorous, upright habit. Mature at 4' – 8'.

Camellia – Arctic Dawn - Camellia x ‘Arctic Dawn’ – Arctic Dawn Camellia

Large, brilliant coral-pink blooms cover dark evergreen foliage in late winter through mid-spring. Flowers are heart shaped, semi-double to peony in form. Cold hardy. Vigorous and upright. Mature at 8’- 10’ x 6’ – 8’.

Camelia – Autumn Spirit - Camellia x Autumn Spirit – Autumn Spirit Camellia

In the fall this broadleaf evergreen is covered with pink, small to medium sized, peony-like flowers. Considered an early blooming variety, this vigorous shrub makes a nice addition to a border or foundation planting, hedge or as a specimen in the landscape. Mature at 5’ – 6’ tall and wide.

Camellia – Long Island Pink - Camellia x ‘Long Island Pink’ – Long Island Pink Camellia

This camellia has lovely single pink flowers in mid-fall. New foliage emerges bronze and turns an intriguing dark glossy green. Nice compact, upright habit. Mature at 10’ x 8’.

Cotinus – Winecraft Black®- Smokebush Proven Winners

A deciduous shrub with purple-black foliage. Blooms are pink-red and look like rusty smoke hanging over the foliage.

An outstanding accent plant for an eclectic garden.

Dwarf, upright habit. Mature at 4’ – 6’ tall and wide.

Ilex - Straight & Narrow® - First® Editions - Ilex crenata ‘PIIC-I’ Straight & Narrow Japanese Holly

PP29,578. An upright, columnar Japanese holly. An excellent choice for privacy in a small space, or as an accent or specimen plant. Mature at 6’ - 8’ tall x 2’ – 3’ wide.

Pieris – ‘Historyland Supreme’ - Pieris japonica – ‘Historyland Supreme’ Japanese Andromeda

Later setting flower buds than other Pieris japonica varieties. White blooms are long lasting. Very compact, upright growth habit. Low maintenance. Mature at 6’ x 6’ tall and wide. Zone 5. #3



Rhus – Tiger Eyes® - First® Editions - Rhus typhina ‘Bailtiger’ – Tiger Eyes® Cutleaf Staghorn Sumac

PP16,185 An outstanding and unique accent plant. Upward angled branching is juxtaposed to downward draping cutleaf foliage, which emerges chartreuse, quickly changing to yellow, both contrasting nicely with rosy-pink stems and scarlet in the fall. Upright and rounded growth habit. Mature at 6’ tall and wide. Zone 4. #3



Syringa – Ludwig Spaeth - Syringa vulgaris ‘Ludwig Spaeth’ – Ludwig Spaeth Lilac

A tall, deciduous shrub, excellent in a mixed border or in masses with other lilacs. Beautiful, single, dark purple, heavily fragrant blooms in late spring. Mature at 6’ - 10’ x 6’ – 8’. Zone 3. #3



Viburnum opulus Sterile

Bright green foliage appears before pure white flower clusters like snowballs adorn this tall shrub. The fall the foliage turns purplish-red. A striking specimen plant in any garden. Deciduous. Mature at 12’ x 10’. Zone 3. #7

Ornamental Trees



Acer – Celebration® - Acer x freemanii ‘Celzam’ - Celebration® Maple

A lovely maple tree, equally suited to street plantings, parks or residential lawns. Naturally symmetrical habit with strong open branching. Foliage is a crisp green, turning an attractive yellow with red hues in the fall. Fast growing. Mature at 40’ – 50’ x 20’- 35’. Zone 4. #7



Cercidiphyllum – Hanna’s Heart® - Cercidiphyllum japonicum ‘Biringer’ – Hanna’s Heart® Katsura

PP21,711. An upright, columnar Katsura tree with deep green, characteristically heart-shaped foliage. Foliage turns yellow in autumn. Slow growing and a good choice for small landscapes. Mature at 20’ – 25’ x 10’.

Hibiscus – Azurri Satin® - Hibiscus syriacus ‘DVPazurri’ – Azurri Satin® Rose of Sharon

PP# 20,563. A tall upright, deciduous rose of Sharon with striking blue flowers, which produce few to no seeds. Long season of bloom. Low maintenance. Attracts butterflies and resists deer. Mature at 8’ – 12’ x 4’ – 6’.

Lagerstroemia – Colorama™ Scarlet – Lagerstroemia ‘JMI’ Colorama™ - Colorama™ Scarlet Crapemyrtle

PP31,1585. Masses of scarlet-red flowers emerge over deep green foliage in summer and lasts well into fall. Attracts birds and butterflies. An excellent, deciduous landscape specimen with a vigorous, self-branching habit. Mature at 15’ – 20’ x 8’ – 12’, Zone 6. #15 Multi-stem #15 Standard



Lagerstroemia - Miss Frances – Lagerstroemia indica ‘Miss Frances’

A new Crapemyrtle introduction with deep red flowers and lustrous green foliage. This selection has a rounded, spreading habit, extended bloom time and lovely grey-orange bark for winter interest. Disease and pest resistant. Mature at 15’ – 20’ x 10’ – 15’.

Lagerstroemia – Tonto Crapemyrtle - Lagerstroemia indica x fauriei – Tonto Crapemyrtle

Semi-dwarf, multi-stemmed growth habit. One of the best cold hardy red selections. Light tan exfoliating bark. Mature size 10’ tall and wide.

Lagerstroemia – Zuni - Lagerstroemia indica x fauriei
Globose, semi-dwarf, multi-stemmed growth habit. Medium lavender flowers from mid-July to late September. Mature 9' x 8'.

Magnolia Soulangeana 'Genie' - Magnolia soulangeana x M. liliflora 'Genie' Genie Magnolia
PP20,748. A small, pyramidal tree. Dramatic, lightly fragrant, deep maroon-purple flowers open before the foliage appears. A second or repeat bloom occurs in late summer. This selection makes a nice accent or specimen plant. Mature at 10' – 13' x 5'.

Prunus – Pink Cascade Weeping Peach - Prunus persica – Pink Cascade Weeping Peach
Double, bright pink flowers on this ornamental weeping peach tree provide a colorful welcome to spring. Rounded, weeping habit. Excellent for small landscapes. Mature at 12' – 15' x 10' – 12'.

Roses



David Austin® – Bathsheba™ - Rosa Auschimbley – Bathsheba™ Climbing David Austin® Rose
A short English Climbing rose. Apricot-yellow buds open to shallowly cupped, many petalled rosettes. Blooms are a beautiful blend of subtle apricot-pink and soft yellow, resembling apricot with creamy outer petals. Medium-strong, superb scent of myrrh with hints of honey and tea. Repeat blooming. Mature at 10' tall.

David Austin® - Eglantyne - Rosa Auasmak – Eglantyne David Austin® Rose
A truly beautiful rose with perfectly formed soft pink blooms and a charming, sweet Old Rose fragrance. Exceptionally healthy and reliable. Large shrub habit. Repeat flowering. Mature at 5' x 4'.

**David Austin® – Gabriel Oak - Rosa Auscrowd –
Gabriel Oak David Austin® Rose**

Large, deep-pink blooms are borne on mulberry-purple stems making a lovely contrast with the deep green foliage. Blooms are many petaled rosettes which over time pale slightly towards the outer edges. Strong, fruity fragrance. A shapely, broad and rounded rose with vigorous growth. Repeat blooming. Mature at 4' tall and wide. Zone 4. #3



**David Austin® - Charles Darwin - Rosa Auspect –
Charles Darwin David Austin® Rose**

Large blooms are yellow to mustard in color and have a strong tea to pure lemon fragrance. The flowers begin very full and rounded, later opening to shallow cups. A sturdy shrub with broad spreading growth. Large shrub habit. Mature at 4 ½' x 4'. Repeat flowering. Zone 5. #3



**David Austin® - Gentle Hermoine - Rosa Ausrumba –
Gentle Hermoine David Austin® Rose**

Slightly arching stems hold perfectly formed, shallow, cuplike blooms of light pink, which pales to soft blush on the outer petals. The fragrance is of warm myrrh. New foliage is tinged with red, becoming green as it matures. A medium, broad shrub habit. Mature at 4' x 3'. Repeat flowering. Zone 5. #3



**David Austin® - Golden Celebration® - Rosa Ausgold –
Golden Celebration® David Austin® Rose**

One of the largest flowered English roses. Flowers are giant cups of rich yellow on long arching branches. Luscious fragrance of strong tea, Sauternes wine and strawberry. Large, nicely rounded, shrub habit with ample foliage. Mature at 4 ½' tall and wide. Repeat flowering. Zone 5. #3



**David Austin® - James Galway™ - Rosa Auscrystal –
James Galway™ David Austin® Rose**

Strikingly beautiful, medium sized, light pink, slightly dome-shaped blooms are made up of numerous neat, nicely placed petals. Blooms are darker towards the centers. Fragrance is light to medium Old Rose. Vigorous grower, medium climbing habit. Mature at 12' tall. Repeat flowering. Zone 4. #3



**David Austin® - Princess Alexandra of Kent -
Rosa Ausmerchant –**

Unusually large, bright pink blooms are full petalled and deeply cupped. A lovely fragrance of strong tea becoming lemon with hints of black currants. A nicely poised rose which is never clumsy. Well -rounded shrub habit. Mature at 5' x 4'.

Repeat flowering.

David Austin® - Scepter'd Isle - Rosa Ausland –

Medium sized light-pink blooms which pale on the outer petals are borne above the foliage. A pretty rose bearing numerous cupped flowers with yellow stamens. Strong myrrh fragrance.

Elegant, upright, large shrub habit. Mature at 5' x 4'.

Repeat flowering.

David Austin® - St. Swithun - Rosa Auswith

Large saucer-like, soft pink blooms have a medium-strong myrrh fragrance. Flower petals pale to blush towards the edges and are highlighted by plentiful greyish-green foliage. Short climbing habit. Repeat flowering. Mature at 10'.

**David Austin® - Susan William Ellis - Rosa Ausquirk –
Susan William-Ellis David Austin® Rose**

Medium sized white blooms have a medium-strong myrrh fragrance with typical Old Rose characteristics. Disease free.

Medium shrub habit. Repeat flowering. Mature at 4 ½' x 3 ½'.

**David Austin® - The Albrighton Rambler® -
Rosa Ausmobile**

A charming rambling rose with small, fully double, cup-shaped flowers having a light Musk fragrance. Blooms are blush pink fading to blush white and borne in graceful hanging sprays. Short rambling habit. Mature at 10' tall. Repeat flowering.

**David Austin® - The Generous Gardener® -
Rosa Ausdrawn –**

Beautifully formed, medium sized, pale-pink flowers nod gracefully on their stems. Flowers have a strong, Old Rose, musk and myrrh fragrance. Petals open to expose numerous stamens giving an almost water lily appearance. Medium climbing habit. Mature at 15' tall. Repeat flowering.

David Austin® - The Lark Ascending - Rosa Ausursula

Medium sized apricot blooms with a light tea/myrrh fragrance. Flowers are graceful, semi-double and borne in large heads of up to 15 nicely spaced blooms. An extremely healthy shrub with a tall airy growth habit. Mature at 5 ½' tall and wide. Repeat flowering.

David Austin® - The Pilgrim® - Rosa Auswalker – The Pilgrim® David Austin Rose

A lovely, fragrance perfectly balanced of medium tea and myrrh. Large soft-yellow blooms are particularly beautiful, with buds opening as many petalled cups later forming flat rosettes. Petals fade towards the edges. Medium climbing habit. Mature at 12' tall. Repeat flowering.

David Austin® – Silas Marner® - Rosa Ausraveloe –

Medium, soft, pink, cupped blooms on red stems. Blooms are medium sized, pale on the reverse and fade at the edges. Petals are almost ruffled and arranged around a button eye. Medium strong, Old Rose scent with hints of fruity lemon, green banana and apricot. A very healthy, medium sized shrub rose with wide arching growth. Repeat flowering. Mature at 3 ½' x 4 ½'.

**David Austin® – Strawberry Hill Climbing Rose
Rosa Ausrimini**

A short climbing rose, beautiful at all stages. Large, mid-pink cupped rosettes borne in small clusters on arching branches with glossy, dark green foliage. Strong, delicious myrrh scent with hints of heather honey. Repeat flowering. Mature at 10'.

David Austin® – Thomas À Beckett™-

Rosa Auswinston

Informal rosettes of crimson-red nod on their stems. Natural shrubby growth habit. Medium Old Rose fragrance and distinct lemon zest. Characteristics are similar to the Species Rose. Repeat flowering. Mature at 5' x 4'.

David Austin® – Windemere- Rosa Aushomer

Perfectly rounded buds open to full, cupped flowers of creamy yellow fading to almost pure white in the sun. Medium-strong fruity fragrance with definite hints of citrus. Repeat flowering. Very healthy, neat and compact. Mature 4' x 3'.

David Austin® – Wollerton Old Hall Climbin Rose -

Rosa Ausblanket

Beautifully rounded, chalice-shaped blooms of pale apricot, start as buds with attractive flashes of red. Blooms eventually pale to cream. Wonderfully fragrant with a strong myrrh fragrance and intense hints of citrus. Medium sized climber.

Repeat flowering. Mature at 12'.

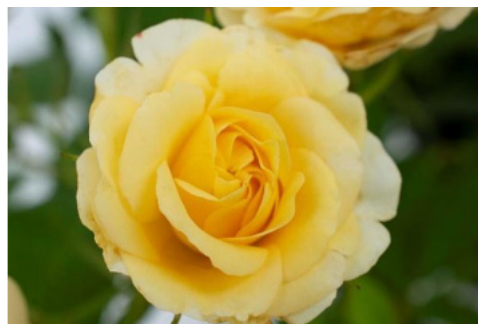

PP23,354 Apricot colored flowers in spring and summer providing a long season display. Tough and disease resistant. True groundcover habit. Mature at 1 ½' x 2 ½'.

Drift® Buttercream – Buttercream Drift®

PPAF Blooms start light yellow to cream colored and finish pure white. Very bushy, compact habit. Very slightly scented. Mature at 1 ½' x 2'.

Sunblaze® Lemon – Lemon Sunblaze®

PPTBS Attractive lemon-yellow flowers unfurl from classically shaped buds. Flowers finish in shades of cream to white. Very slightly scented. Bushy, compact and rounded habit. Mature at 1 ½' tall and wide.

Sunblaze® Peach – Peach Sunblaze®

PPTBS Multicolored flowers are a unique combination of orange, pink and yellow giving an over-all peach effect. Slightly scented. Bushy, compact and rounded habit. Mature 1 ½' tall and wide.

Sunblaze® Salmon – Salmon Sunblaze®

Coral colored flowers are stunning and beautiful against nice, glossy foliage. Good disease resistance. Slightly scented. A medium, compact, miniature rose. Mature at 12" – 15" x 15".

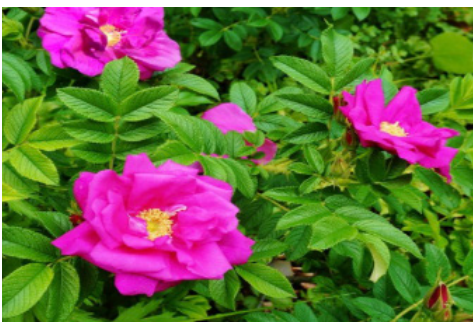


Rugosa Rose – Pink Pavement Rugosa Rose

Large semi-double blooms vary in color from deep pink to mauve. A heavy spring flush occasionally repeated in the season. Winter hardy and disease resistant. Very slightly scented.

Upright habit. Mature at 3' - 5' x 3'- 4'.

Rugosa Rose – Purple Pavement – Purple Pavement Rugosa Rose

A heavy spring flush of large, ruffled, semi-double blooms in purple-red color, occasionally repeating in season.

Brightly colored hips and red foliage for added fall interest.

Strong fragrance. Mature at 3'- 6' tall and wide.

**Hybrid Tea Rose – Eleganza® Wedding Bells -
Wedding Bells Eleganza®**

PP23,570 Very large, long lasting, two-toned, pink blooms are strongly fragrant and make good cut flowers. Lovely, shiny green foliage adds charm. Performs well in rainy climates. Medium, upright habit. Mature at 5' x 3'.

Hybrid Tea Rose – Honor™

Long stems, deep green foliage and pure white flower color make this an excellent rose for cutting. Slight classic Hybrid Tea Rose fragrance. Very tall, upright habit.

Mature at 4' -5' x 3 - 4'.

Hybrid Tea Rose - Raspberry Cupcake™

PP33,406 An attractive rose with pink to purple-colored blooms and a strong raspberry fragrance with hints of rose water and lemon. Repeat bloomer with excellent resistance to mildews and rust. Bushy habit. Mature at 4' x 2' - 3'.

Hybrid Tea Rose – Voodoo

An enchantingly rich, fruity fragrance and intriguing blend of yellow, peach and deep orange make for a spellbinding rose. Lovely glossy foliage and a repeat bloomer.

Very tall, upright habit. Mature at 5' x 3' – 4'.
